Chamberlin announces candidacy for South Bend Common Council

Kyle Chamberlin (Independent) has announced his candidacy for the District Four seat on the South Bend Common Council. An attorney with experience in criminal prosecution and private practice, Chamberlin is currently a member of the University of Notre Dame faculty.

As an independent candidate, Chamberlin will not participate in the May party primary elections. He is currently collecting voter signatures for nomination by petition to the November general election ballot. Chamberlin, 26, will be promoting SB4g, his vision for the next generation of South Bend. At the heart of SB4g is a simplification of municipal goals and focus on existing strengths. "The challenges facing South Bend are complex and merit thorough discourse. We face questions too great to be answered by one individual or one party – big problems require bold thinking." Chamberlin said. "I recognize many will question my non-conventional approach. My response is simple: What about the way our city has elected leaders for the last fifty years has worked?"

Chamberlin is a homeowner in the Harter Heights neighborhood and a lifelong resident of Michiana. He holds a Bachelors of Business Administration and a Juris Doctor from the the University of Notre Dame. A citizen member on the Common Council's PARC Committee, Chamberlin is active with the Young Professionals Network and the United Way of St. Joseph County.
